RESOLUTION NO. 12-11

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE PERIOD OF LOCAL EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on March 22, 2011 the Steele County Board of Commissioners adopted a resolution declaring that a state of emergency existed within Steele County brought on by the flooding event starting on March 17th, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Chair of the Owatonna City Council temporarily authorized a State of Emergency for the City of Owatonna on March 17th, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Owatonna concur in and ratify that declaration and, further, find that the state of emergency exists for a period longer than three (3) days; and

WHEREAS, the following conditions exist within the City of Owatonna with the potential for extensive property damage and infrastructure damage as a result to the flooding;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Owatonna, as follows:

1. That the state of emergency previously declared exists within the City and the City Council is authorized to exercise the powers and responsibilities attending thereto all as provided by Chapter 12 of the Minnesota Statutes.
